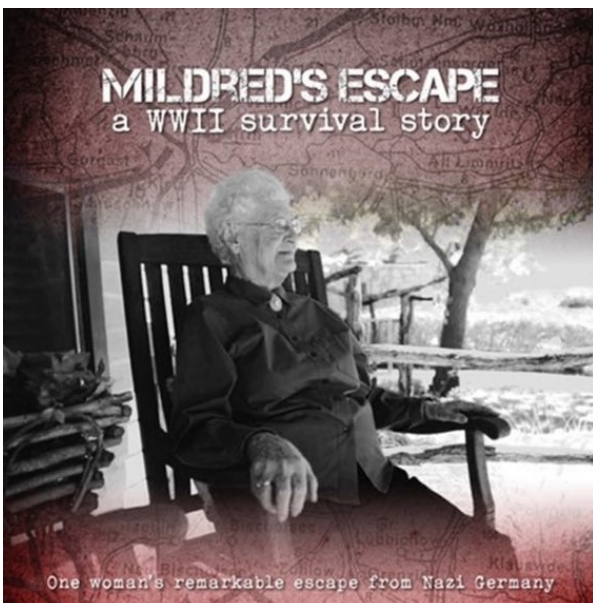

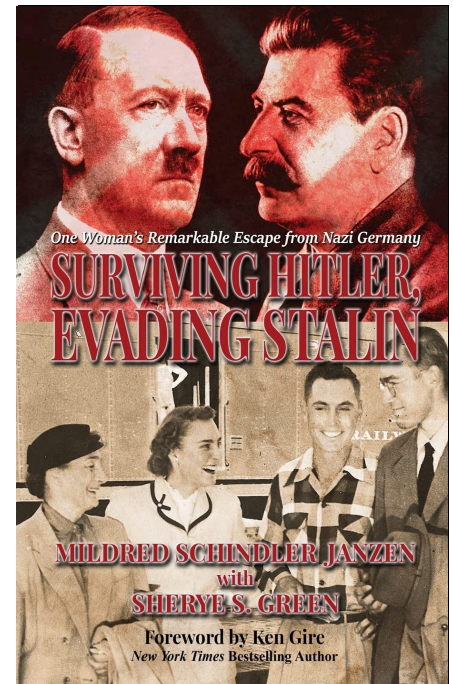

Parkside is partnering with a vending company called Mahaska to offer a new Micro Market experience to residents and staff of Parkside. We will have two Micro Markets on campus, one in the Employee Break-room of the Healthcare Center and one adjacent to the dining room of the Parkside Apartments. These will be installed early June and will offer a larger variety of sandwiches, fruit, snacks, candy, and drinks such as juices, teas, soda, and energy drinks. The layout of the Micro Market is one that allows for self-service with a place to scan the merchandise that you are purchasing and pay for it right on the kiosk. Mahaska will take care of monitoring the Micro Markets through camera and the use of the Wi-Fi in the designated areas. Our hope is that it can give the residents and staff more choices right here conveniently on Parkside Campus.



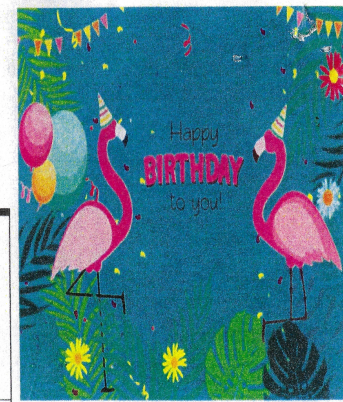

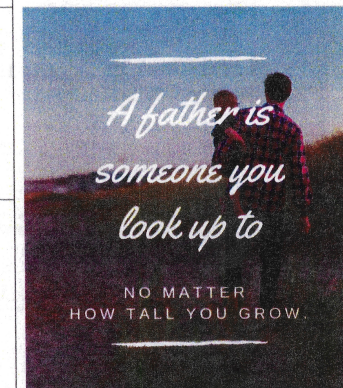
